going deeper

1. What does Paul mean in writing that we were "called to be free"? (Galatians 5:13)
 2. How can Paul rightly say that the whole Law is fulfilled in keeping this one command "Love your neighbor as yourself"? (Galatians 5:14)
 3. How have you personally experienced the desires of the Spirit and the desires of the flesh to be at odds with one another? (Galatians 5:16-23)
 4. How might you better use the freedom you have found in the gospel, not to indulge the flesh but rather serve one another out of love? (Galatians 5:13-15)
 5. What fleshly passions and desires have you crucified, and what passions and desires are you currently crucifying? (Galatians 5:24)
 6. What does it mean to "keep in step with the Spirit," and what does this look like in your life? (Galatians 5:25)
 7. How can people be praying for you this week, as you look to live out what you have learned from this passage into your life? Spend time praying with/for one another.
