### going deeper

1. Considering the armor of God listed in Ephesians 6:14-18, on a scale of one to ten, how ready are you for battle?
  - Belt of Truth: a lifestyle of honesty and integrity (John 3:19-21)
  - Breastplate of Righteousness: confidence in Christ (Romans 3:21-24)
  - Boots of the Gospel: actively sharing the good news (Philemon 1:6)
  - Shield of Faith: belief in God's good purposes (Romans 8:18-39)
  - Helmet of Salvation: identity in Christ (Ephesians 1:15-23)
  - Sword of the Spirit; attacking sin and Satan with Scripture (Hebrews 4:12)
2. Describe a time when you successfully utilized God's armor and the impact it made in your life.
3. Considering the pieces of God's armor, which do most often successfully utilize, and how do they strengthen your life of faith?
4. Which pieces of God's armor do you need to be more intentional about putting on, and how might wearing them strengthen your life of faith?
5. How can others be praying for you during the week ahead, as you look to act upon God's Word?
